Apply for a Habitat for Humanity house.

Families wishing to apply must:

- be Warren County residents for at least 1 year;
 - be currently living in inadequate or unaffordable housing;
- and*
- have a total family income between 30% and 60% of the HUD median, adjusted for family size. (Ex.: \$19,200 - \$38,400 for family of 4).

The family selected will enter into partnership with Volunteers from Warren County Habitat for Humanity to build the family's new, affordable, 2- or 3-bedroom home (as appropriate for family size) in Warren County.
